Learners must come dressed to school in their PE kit. (No learner may participate in school uniform) It would be advisable for learners to wear a cap/hat & carry their sunblock.

All learners must carry a water bottle.

NB: Grades R to 3 will continue with normal Physical Education lessons.



Drop-off and pick up of Learners: As mentioned at the AGM, we will be making some changes to our drop-off and pick-up process. We are planning to implement this change from Monday, 5 December 2022 in preparation for the 2023 School Year when we will have all our parents back on the premises. From Monday, 5 December all learners may be dropped off at their classes or at the school gate. School continues to start at 07h25 and we will have morning line up for the learners when the bell rings at the start of the day. Foundation Phase learners will line up outside the Grade 1 and 2 classrooms, the Grade 4-6

learners will line up at the flagpole area and the Grade 7 learners will line up in the Grade 7 Quad. Learners will be shown where they are expected to line up in the course of the week.

For pick up, the major change is that we will no longer call the learners to the gate but instead parents will be allowed to enter the school premises to pick up their child. Please see table below for the pick-up details.

Parents can use the area near the planters, outside the tuck shop area while waiting for their children to be dismissed. We ask parents not to converge or linger at the pick-up venues, as this will cause congestion and frustration to other parents who are trying to collect their children. We appeal to all parents to please collect their child and move on as soon as possible. At this stage, the limited number of parking bays will be the biggest challenge and we urge all parents to please be considerate of the time taken, especially due to the limited parking bays. Please take note we have three gates that you can use for pick-up. These gates are the Bottom or Field Gate on St Audley Road,

Jeff's gate at Bantry Road and Thomas' Gate on Ballina Road. For drop off you may use Jeff's gate at Bantry Road and Thomas' Gate on Ballina Road. Parents are reminded that the school, unfortunately, has no control or authority on the parking outside the school, as this area falls under the authority of the JMPD and the JRA. We will ask for assistance from the JMPD to help monitor the situation. We will also be implementing our Scholar Patrol Teams from early in 2023. Let's all work together to ensure the safety of our learners and I ask for all parents' assistance and co-operation in this regard.
