NB: Grades R to 3 will continue with normal Physical Education lessons.

Pick up of Learners: As mentioned at the AGM we will be making some changes to our pick-up process. The major change will be that we will no longer call the learners to the gate but instead parents will be allowed to enter the school premises to pick up their child. We are planning to implement this change before the end of the 2022 School Year in preparation for the 2023 School Year when we hope to have all our parents back on the premises as it was, before the Lockdown forced changes to how we operated. At this stage the limited number of parking bays will be the biggest hinderance and we are revising the best way to relieve what will be, the major cause of frustration to the parents. We will provide further communication in due cause.

Fundraising: Soap Box Derby: The last major Fundraising event for this year will be the Soap Box Derby which is scheduled to take place on Wednesday, 30 November. This is an event that is extremely popular with our learners. And there are a number of prizes are up for grabs on the day. One of the highlights is always the Parents vs the Bryneven Staff race at the end. Coupled with the chance to make an impression with the class/grade music as they try to strut/bounce/dance/march past the judges, it is an event not to be missed. Parents will be allowed to attend this function with further information to be distributed by the Fundraising Committee closer to the event.



Early Closure for School: Earlier this term we made an application to close school slightly earlier this year. The date for end of year for the learners was originally scheduled for Wednesday, 14 December 2022. Our application was approved, and the revised date is Friday, 09 December 2022 which will now be the last day of school for our learners. The report cards will also be distributed on this date.

This will not affect the Foundation or Intermediate Phase Awards functions but will have an impact on the Grade 7 functions which will now move to a different date.
